INTERPLASTICA 2020 – POST-SHOW REPORT

Moscow, January 28-31, 2020

The 23rd INTERPLASTICA - organized by Messe Düsseldorf - took place at Expo-centr fairgrounds in Moscow on January 28-31, 2020, occupying three halls (1, 2 and 8 - the two latter subdivided in three sections respectively) on a net surface of 14,000 sqm.

As usual, the event was concurrent with UPAKOVKA, devoted to the packaging industry, which again was hosted in Hall Forum.

According to the organizers, INTERPLASTICA registered 670 exhibitors (680 in 2019, 650 in 2018, 570 in 2017, 616 in 2016) from the following countries:

Attending companies covered the entire plastics and rubber production chain: from raw materials producers to semi- and finished products manufacturers, from machinery/equipment/moulds makers to services, recycling solutions providers.

Official country participations were organized by: Austria (14 exhibitors within the national pavilion), China (102), Germany (92), Italy (41).

INTERPLASTICA 2020 hosted again the satellite show 3D fab+print Russia, devoted to additive manufacturing and 3D printing.

For the first time, 50 exhibitors from the recycling sector were gathered together in hall 8.1, within the side event "Recycling Solutions".

The organizer estimated 24,000 visitors (24,950 in 2019, 24,900 in 2018, 23,000 in 2017, 20,900 in 2016) attended the exhibition, coming mainly from Russia and the neighboring Republics.

Next INTERPLASTICA will take place from January 26 to 29, 2021.
